6th generation, family owned (and managed) 24 acres of vineyards, in the historic Grand Cru town of Vezernay, in the heart of Montagne de Reims.

Specialist of Pinot Noir, producing unique 'Blanc de Noirs' champagnes - made entirely from Pinot Noir grapes - including an 'Extra Brut' with no dosage, and a rarity: a Rose Grand Cru Champagne, made exclusively with Pinot Noir.

Assailly

For more than 100 years, the Assailly family have been making wines of incredible finesse.

20 acres planted exclusively to Chardonnay, producing Blanc de Blancs, that exemplifies the soils of Avize (most famous part of the Côte des Blancs in Champagne).

Only Grand Cru Champagnes of elegance, balance and much character, often with little or no dosage.

Paul Berthelot

Dizy, just north of Epernay, is home to 32 acres of family-run vineyards, currently being managed by the 5th generation of the Berthelot family.

Predominantly Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, in equal measure, with some amazing Pinot Noir (La Libertine, Blanc de Noirs, made only with Pinot Meunier).

True to the ethics and practices of their founders, Berthelot produce a variety of styles of Champagne, each with its own characteristics.

Andre Tixier & Fils

10 acres of sustainably-farmed vineyards in the Reims mountains, managed by 3rd and 4th generations of the Tixier family.

The champagnes are composed of 3 grape varieties - Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

Finesse and elegance are the keys of the Domaine.
